

## Biography

Jemima Burrill grew up in London, and studied Visual Anthropology and Linguistics in Manchester in the 80s, going back to study at Chelsea School of Art and then at the Royal College of Art in the sculpture departments. Her videos have been shown internationally, including at the Museum of Modern Art in Lyon, Perth Institute of Contemporary Art, Arts Santa Monica, Barcelona; Florence Lynch Gallery, New York; and in various shows with the Pacific Design Centre, LA. Her performances have infiltrated the Barbican, Ace Hotel, the Freud Museum, Nohat, Newington Green Church celebrating Mary Wollstonecraft, Central St Martins and Up Project's Floating Cinema. She is represented by Galerie Houg, Lyon and hosts CREATIVE BOOST an Instagram live where creatives talk about their creative practice and their inspiration.
